## **Understanding Your Utility Bill**



<u>Account Number</u>: If you mail your payment, please provide account number on your check or money order.

<u>Due Date</u>: Your bill is due on this date to avoid penalty action. Payments can be made online, by phone, bank draft, drop/deposit box, or in person. Go to <u>www.beevilletx.org/departments/UtilityBilling</u> for more info.

3 <u>From & To Dates:</u> The service period of your bill. The service date range will be from previous month.

<u>Readings</u>: The meter readings from start of service date to ending service date.

5 <u>Amount Due Now</u>: This is the amount that must be paid by the Due Date to avoid penalty action. Monthly statement includes charges for water, sewer, and garbage services.

<sup>6</sup> <u>Previous Balance</u>: Amount unpaid from prior billing period.

<u>Amount Due After Due Date</u>: This is the amount that must be paid if payment is made AFTER the Due Date (includes penalties).

8 <u>Location</u>: The address that receives the water, sewer, and/or garbage service.

Billing Date: The date your bill was prepared and mailed to you.

Red postcards are Disconnect Notices that indicate delinquent status accounts that should be paid immediately to avoid disconnection of services.
