Candidate Eligibility Requirements Requisitos de Elegibilidad del Candidato
<p>Candidates for the office of city council members shall be qualified under the requirements of the Texas Election Code and must be a qualified voter of the city at the time of filing and must be 21 years of age at the time of the election for which they are filing. They must be a current resident of the city and must have been a resident of the city, or of recently annexed territory, for at least 12 months prior to the filing date. They also shall continue to maintain their primary residence within the city for the term of office.</p>
